

#### **Use Natural Contexts and Follow** the Child's Lead

Teaching language in daily routines and play increases the frequency of learning and communication opportunities.

## **Model Language on the Device**

Point to the picture symbols and words on the device as you talk to your child. Model without expectation to imitate or respond.

## **Use Wait Time**

Pause when communicating with your child using the AAC device to give them time to respond. Honor all communication the child uses when they respond to you.

#### **Provide Opportunity to Use the AAC Device**

Always have the AAC device available for your child. Keep the device charged and help your child remember to bring the device with them wherever they go.
